

How to Apply

1. Meet with an Admissions Advisor
2. Meet with a Financial Aid Counselor*
3. Complete the Free Application for Federal Student Aid (FAFSA) online at www.fafsa.gov
4. Apply online at www.icohs.edu
5. Submit a copy of:
 - Government issued ID
 - High School Transcripts or Diploma
6. Take the Entry Assessment Test at goo.gl/pNHqWR
7. Sign the Enrollment Agreement
8. Get Packaged for Financial Aid*
 - Financial Aid Entrance Counseling Meeting
9. Confirm Enrollment
10. Orientation
11. Begin classes!

How do you Apply for Federal Student Aid?*

1. Create an FSA ID. Students, parents, and borrowers should create an FSA ID online at studentaid.gov/fsaid
2. Complete the Free Application for Federal Student Aid (FAFSA®) www.fafsa.gov
3. Add ICoHS to your FAFSA: Federal School Code: 042655
4. Review your Student Aid Report: After you apply, you will receive a Student Aid Report, or SAR.

Orientation Checklist

1. Arrive to mandatory orientation at least 30 minutes prior to class to find parking
2. Be prepared to get your picture taken for your Student ID
3. Bring pens and other school supplies
4. Bring yoga mat to use in class after orientation
5. Bring snacks and water bottle to fill up throughout the day

Veteran Affairs Financial Assistance

If you served as Active Duty, you may be eligible for education benefits offered by the Department of Veterans Affairs. To qualify, you must have received an honorable discharge to be eligible for the Post-9/11 GI-Bill. To check your eligibility, go to: www.benefits.va.gov/gibill
